Do you work in the public sector in Wales?

Do you want to make a difference when addressing violence against women, domestic abuse and sexual violence?

"Ask and Act" is a process of targeted enquiry to be practiced across the Public Service to identify violence against women, domestic abuse, and sexual violence. The term 'targeted enquiry' describes the recognition of indicators of violence against women, domestic abuse, and sexual violence as a prompt for a professional to ask their client whether they have been affected by any of these issues.

The Ask and Act Train The Trainer course equips trainers with the knowledge and skills to deliver training to professionals who will support colleagues as outlined in the statutory guidance detailed in the Violence Against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence (VAWDASV) (Wales) Act 2015.
